Bill is also a very popular teacher who works to satisfy the individual student's needs: and who takes great delight in watching students progress. His teaching philosophy is to simplify the painting procedure to a level easily understood by all students, and then to encourage the individual expression of emotion toward the subject: a grass roots approach.
